

English

This half term, Foxglove Class will dive into the exciting world of traditional tales with a twist, exploring fun retellings of favourites like The Three Little Pigs and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Alongside this, we'll focus on writing and following instructions to help us stay fit and healthy. The children will learn how to create their own eat-well plates and write step-by-step guides for simple, active games. Through stories, discussions, and practical activities, we'll build our reading, writing, and teamwork skills while learning how to make healthy choices every day.

Mathematics

This half term in Maths, Foxglove Class will follow the White Rose Year 2 scheme, focusing on place value and addition and subtraction. We will explore numbers to 100, understanding tens and ones, comparing and ordering numbers, and using number lines. The children will develop their confidence with addition and subtraction through a range of practical methods, including the use of concrete resources, pictorial representations, and number stories. These hands-on activities will support a deep understanding of number relationships and help build strong mental maths strategies. Problem solving and reasoning will be woven throughout to strengthen mathematical thinking.

Science

This half term in Science, Foxglove Class will be learning about healthy choices and what our bodies need to stay alive and grow. We will explore the importance of a balanced diet, identifying foods and drinks that help keep us strong and healthy. The children will learn about the different food groups and how they support our bodies. We will also focus on hygiene and health, including the importance of regular handwashing, exercise, and dental care. To deepen our understanding, we'll speak with professionals such as doctors and dentists about how they help us stay healthy and why looking after our bodies

Outdoor Learning inc. Forest School & Visits

This half term, Foxglove Class will explore outdoor games that raise our heartrate and keep us fit and also have visits from healthcare professionals such as doctors and dentists that will explain the importance of health and making good choices to keep us happy and feeling fit

Music

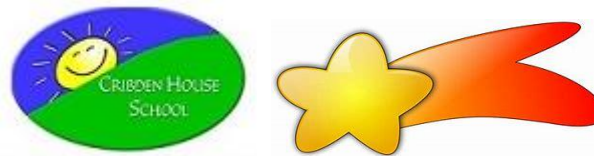
This half term in Music, Foxglove Class will explore how music and movement can help keep us fit and active. Through rhythm games, body percussion, and dance, children will develop coordination, timing, and musical awareness. We will also be introduced to Latin music, learning about its vibrant rhythms, instruments, and cultural roots.

PE & Physical Activity

This half term in PE, Foxglove Class will be developing their fundamental movement skills through the Year 2 unit from PE Passport. The focus will be on building coordination, balance, agility, and control through a range of fun and engaging activities. Children will take part in games and challenges designed to improve skills such as running, jumping, hopping, and throwing.

Foxgloves Class



RE

This half term in RE, Foxglove Class will be exploring Hinduism through the Jigsaw scheme. We will learn about key aspects of Hindu beliefs, including important symbols, festivals, and stories. Children will discover how Hindu families show their faith in daily life and celebrate special occasions such as Diwali. Through stories, discussions, and creative activities, we will explore values such as respect, kindness, and belonging.

Computing

This half term in Computing, Foxglove Class will begin exploring coding using the Purple Mash scheme. Children will be introduced to basic coding concepts such as algorithms, sequencing, and debugging through fun, interactive activities. They will learn how to create simple programs by giving instructions to make characters move or complete tasks on screen. Using age-appropriate tools, pupils will begin to understand how digital devices follow commands and how to spot and fix errors in their code. This unit supports logical thinking, problem solving, and creativity, laying the foundation for future computing skills in a fun and engaging way.

Art & Design

This half term in Art and Design, Foxglove Class will explore a range of methods for creating art, with a focus on drawing and painting. Children will experiment with different tools and materials to develop their fine motor skills and creativity. They will learn techniques such as shading, blending, and colour mixing, and use these to create artwork inspired by real-life objects and their own imaginations. We will also look at the work of famous artists to inspire our creations and discuss how art can be used to express ideas and emotions. The focus will be on developing confidence and enjoyment in making art.

PSHRE

This half term in PSHRE, Foxglove Class will follow the Jigsaw scheme and explore the unit Being Me in My World. Pupils will learn about their place in the class, school, and wider community, and reflect on what makes them special. They will explore themes such as belonging, responsibilities, and how to work and play cooperatively with others. The children will also discuss how to express their feelings, set simple goals, and understand the importance of rules. This unit helps build self-awareness, empathy, and a strong sense of classroom community from the start of the year.
