

### **English**

Roses will engage with biography writing to enhance their English skills. They will explore the structure and features of biographies, focusing on notable figures. Through guided writing exercises, pupils will develop their ability to research and present information cohesively, fostering both creativity and comprehension.

### **Mathematics**

This half term Roses will deepen their understanding of mathematical concepts by focusing on addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Emphasis will be placed on exchanging when subtracting and using practical strategies for multiplication and division. This approach will enhance problem-solving skills and build confidence in their mathematical abilities.

**Science**. Roses will explore the concept of light, investigating its sources, properties, and behaviours. Through practical experiments and observational activities, learners will develop their understanding of how light interacts with objects, the importance of shadows, and the formation of rainbows.

### **Outdoor Learning inc.**

This term's outdoor learning will have a thematic approach towards big events in the calendar such as Bonfire night and Christmas whilst linking with a scheme of outdoor learning.

**PSHRE** - Celebrating difference through the Jigsaw approach. This unit encourages children to explore diversity, fostering respect and understanding among peers. Activities will promote empathy, acceptance, and recognition of unique qualities.

**PE & Physical Activity** students will develop their football skills through engaging activities that emphasise teamwork, technical proficiency, and strategic play, fostering both physical fitness and social interaction

**Humanities** - Our thematic approach of "No Place Like Home," students explored the rich history and diverse geographical features of Lancashire. This inquiry-based learning fostered a deep appreciation for the region's heritage, from its industrial past to its scenic landscapes.

### **Computing**

**Coding-** Students will engage with Purple Mash's ICT curriculum, focusing on Unit 3.2 Online Safety, where two lessons will be dedicated to understanding safe online practices. ### **RE**

This lesson will encourage collaboration and critical thinking, enabling pupils to reflect on the significance of Christian traditions and their relevance in contemporary society, fostering a deeper understanding of the holiday's essence.

### **MFL**

**Spanish** - The class will explore the vocabulary related to days of the week and months of the year. Through interactive activities, such as songs and games, learners will enhance their pronunciation and memory skills, fostering a deeper understanding of the Spanish language while enjoying engaging cultural contexts.
