

English/Communication & Language

Throughout this term we will focus on both fiction and non-fiction texts that link to our topic area 'Transport'.

We will look at a range of texts at our reading level including ORT and Fireflies. Your child will learn to recognise words on labels and match them to pictures and real life objects.

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills and practise forming letters to write simple words; car, bus, boat.

Mathematics

Within this unit we will focus on the following;

- To understand that counting is to find out how many
- To identify that fewer means when items have been removed
- To use blocks to create own simple structures
- To arrange items in own patterns

Activities will be carried out on a 1:1/1:2 ratio and will be practical and hands on.

PSHRE

Throughout this half term we will be focussing on personal development. Children will be provided with opportunities to;

- Show an awareness of sharing and taking turns
- Initiate interaction and engage positively with peers
- Attempt to join others' play
- Share experiences with others

Physical Development

This half term we will be focusing on striking & fielding, your child will learn;

- How to throw an object overarm at a target
- How to roll a ball for my partner to chase and receive a thrown ball
- How to strike a ball from a tee
- Different tactics in a range of simple games

Knowledge of the World

Throughout this unit we will look at the following;

An introduction to transport including different modes on the ground, in the air and on water. We will compare transport over time and look at the features of old and new vehicles.

We will closely observe what different vehicles do.

We will explore and describe different forces on a vehicle, when pushed on different surfaces.

Across the unit we hope to be able to venture outside of school and experience transport using first-hand experience.

Topic

Our theme for this half term is 'Transport'. This is a topic that will allow children to develop their creativity and curiosity.

We will be crafting our own vehicles using a range of materials, we will be designing and testing our own vehicles in different conditions and recording our results. Children will be working together in pairs on a range of set tasks.

Outdoor Learning inc. Forest School & Visits

Our forest sessions this half term will involve cross curricular opportunities.

We will explore a range of activities, including; woodland vehicle simulation, where the children will select their chosen car and drive it over a range of terrains, ramps and slopes. Your child will begin to use sticks, logs and stones to build and construct bridges and pathways.

We will also look at journey mapping and role play.
