The Package: What We Offer

Classroom & Strategy Support (HLTA Lead)

Environmental Audits: A "Specialist Eye" visit to assess the classroom environment (sensory triggers, layout, visual supports) for specific pupils.

Strategy Modelling: An HLTA half-day visit in the classroom to model specific ASC/ADHD strategies for the class teacher and TAs.

Bespoke Interventions: Setting up and launching high-impact interventions.

Positive Behaviour Support Plans: Creating structured, functional behaviour assessments to help staff manage significant behaviour.

Family & Home Engagement (FSW Lead)

Home-School Liaison: Regular home visits to ensure strategies used at school are mirrored at home, reducing student anxiety during transitions.

Early Help Support: Assisting the school's SENCO with Early Help Module (EHM) assessments or EHCP evidence gathering.

Parenting Workshops: Running small-group sessions for parents on topics like "Managing ADHD at Home" or "Communication Aids".

Training & CPD

Twilights: 90-minute staff training on ASC/SLCN awareness.

"Shadowing" Days: Allowing staff to spend a day in our school setting to observe best practices first-hand.
