

English

This term we will be focussing on Folk tales including; Little Red Riding Hood, Snow White, Cinderella, Martin and the dragon, The Morphie Kelpie and The faithful hound. We will also be exploring the biographies of some famous people such as; Roald Dahl, David Attenborough, Oprah Winfrey, Malcolm X and Martin Luther King.

Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on number and place value. We will learn to read and write numbers in words and digits and explore what the digits in numbers represent. We will also represent numbers in different ways and order and compare these. We will then move on to adding and subtracting numbers using a range of practical equipment.

Science

This half term, we will begin by recapped prior learning in science before moving on to identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Forest sessions will focus on our learning plan over the term linking all sessions to our curriculum.
